



Code of Behaviour for Young People & Vulnerable Adults

Policies and Procedures

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St Joseph School is a language school for the education of students, including children aged under 18. All people visiting St Joseph School, either privately or with an organised group, are expected to respect St Joseph School, its staff, students and its buildings and grounds.

St Joseph School seeks to offer visitors a safe and caring environment. In return, you must:

- respect the rights and dignity of each other and of the staff and other helpers;
- respect the rules of St Joseph School.

- Smoking is banned in all buildings at St Joseph School and is only allowed within outdoor areas specifically designed for this practice.
- All rules and safety/emergency procedures such as fire drills must be followed.
- Participants in organised events are expected to attend all timetabled activities unless they have been granted specific leave of absence.
- Inappropriate physical intimacy among participants is not permitted.
- Serious incidents of misbehaviour such as fighting, racial/sexual abuse, damage to property, indecent language and failure to obey instructions will normally lead to expulsion from the activity and St Joseph School.



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
